Listed below are basic information requirements to complete an OCFA plan review.

***Not all items will pertain to your project. ***

- 1. Is the site plan required? Has it been approved?
- 2. Current CBC/CFC code references provided?
- 3. Scope of work defined? Cloud or isolate project area.
- 4. Intent of use – what is the area/building being used for? Chems? Racks? Pool?
- 5. Provide project name, address, tract number?
- 6. Provide a scaled floor plan of the project/building.
- 7. Specify the occupancy group as required by CBC Chapter 3.
- 8. Show construction type.
- 9. Show occupant loads in assembly occupancies.
- 10. OCFA notes black/blue lined onto plans.
- 11. Show exit signs, tactile exit signs.
- 12. Show emergency lighting as required by CBC Section 1006.
- 13. Show panic hardware.
- Sprinkler note per Fire Code and local amendments.
