CHEMICAL CLASSIFICATION PACKETS

Listed below are basic information requirements to complete an OCFA plan review.

Not all items will pertain to your project

- 1. Chemical Classification form.
- 2. Chemical Classification Summary sheet.
- 3. Chemical Classification Summary Total form:

Common name of the chemical – Trade name, like Purple K

Chemical name – Technical name for the pure chemical

Percentage of each chemical in the product

The chemical abstract service number (CAS) – From the material safety data sheet (MSDS)

Form – List the chemical as a liquid (L), solid (S), or gas (G)

Quantity stored – Use the correct measurement format (U.S. – not Metric system)

Quantity in use – Note open or closed system

Location – Note if product is stored in a cabinet, lab room, HPS, open vat, etc.

Hazard class – All hazard classifications for the chemical must be listed

Justification – Indicate where you obtained the classification info
