***Trevor Win'E Memorial Day Fundraiser***

**WHEN:** **Monday, May 28, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.**

**WHERE:** Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) Training Grounds, 1 Fire Authority Road, Irvine. Thomas Brothers, Page 830, H-2.

**WHAT:** Teams from The Orange County Fire Authority will join other teams of elite athletes from CrossFit Gyms, Fire Departments, and Military Units from around the nation and world in performing a workout to raise funds for cooling vests to be donated to US troops. Each four-person team will pay an entry fee of \$160, which purchases and ships one cooling vest to a member of the U.S. Military currently deployed in Iraq or Afghanistan. The Memorial Fund is in memory of Army SPC Trevor Anthony Win'E, a resident of Orange, who was killed in action near Mosul, Iraq May 1st, 2004.
