### ***Mock DUI Crash Scheduled at San Clemente High School***

The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) will be one of several agencies participating in a Mock DUI Crash on February 23 at 9:40 a.m. at San Clemente High School, 700 Avenida Pico, San Clemente.

The event is sponsored by Friends Against Drinking and Driving (FADD) and is designed to teach the students the dangers of drinking and driving. Other agencies participating include the Orange County Sheriff Department, Mission Hospital, Medix Ambulance, Dunnivans Towing, Trauma Intervention Group (TIP) and O'Connor Mortuary.

The scenario for this event will be a collision between two vehicles involving students drinking following the prom. One of the vehicles will be overturned.
