Canyon Residents Invited to Attend Fire Season Meeting

- WHEN:** Friday, June 15, 7 p.m.
- WHERE:** Orange County Fire Authority Fire Station 16, 28951 Modjeska Canyon Road, Thomas Brothers Page 832, G-7. Parking will be available at the main entrance to Modjeska Canyon at Santiago Canyon and Modjeska Canyon Roads.
- WHAT:** Extremely dry conditions exist in the canyon areas, creating conditions for a dangerous fire season. The meeting will provide canyon residents with information on how to prepare for the threat. Subjects will include: clearance and defensible space, evacuation plans, provisions for animals, safety zones if entrapped, sheltering in place; and fire plans and how your property will be defended.
- WHO:** Speakers will include Orange County Fire Authority Deputy Fire Marshal Pete Bonano, Lt. Bill Griffin of the Orange County Sheriff-Coroner and representatives from Orange County Animal Services and the American Red Cross.
