Subject: Structure Fire in Tustin

The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) responded to a structure fire at a single family dwelling at 1722 Brookshire Avenue in Tustin on April 25 at 11:04 a.m.

First arriving units reported smoke showing from the door and an aggressive attack was made on the fire. The fire was handled with the initial first alarm assignment (four engines and a truck) and was placed under control at 11:28 a.m.

Preliminary damage estimates are \$300,000 to the structure and \$150,000 to the contents and the preliminary cause was listed as a cooking fire.

One resident was transported as a moderate status to St. Joseph Hospital in Orange.

Residents are reminded to check their smoke alarms and to practice home evacuation drills on a regular basis.
