

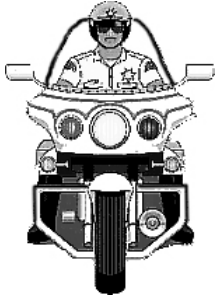

PLEASE ABIDE – MOVE ASIDE

Collisions with emergency vehicles cost dollars and lives. The Orange County Fire Authority wants you and your loved ones to stay safe.



Twelve firefighters and 40 police officers die in motor vehicle crashes each year.



REMEMBER:

PULL TO THE RIGHT AND STOP!

When you see red lights or hear the sirens of emergency vehicles.

IF YOU HEAR A SIREN OR SEE RED EMERGENCY LIGHTS ...

WHILE APPROACHING AN **INTERSECTION**

Stop at the limit line or the crosswalk at the intersection.

Wait for ALL emergency vehicles to pass before getting back on the road. Remember that there may be more than one emergency vehicle on the way.

Don't stop in the middle of the intersection – If the emergency vehicle is behind you, you may move through the intersection on a green traffic signal, and then pull to the right as soon as possible after the intersection.

DON'T panic!
DON'T pull into the intersection against a red traffic signal.

WHILE ON A **ONE WAY STREET**

Pull over to the right when safely able to do so.

Slow down and stop to make a safe lane of passage for the emergency vehicles.

DON'T panic!
DON'T stop in the middle of the road.

WHILE ON THE **FREEWAY**

Continue to move forward at a safe speed.

Pull over to the right when it is safe to do so.

DON'T panic.
DON'T stop on the freeway.
DON'T pull to the left median unless instructed to do so by emergency vehicles.
